### VINTAGE

The 2019 growing season was cooler and crop yields were significantly lower in comparison to the previous two vintages. The lower temperatures delayed ripening and helped retain fresh fruit aromatics and mouthwatering acidity. Despite cold winter conditions, 2019 gave us grapes full of dark fruit flavor and silky tannins with classic Washington State character.

"The 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon offers aromas of black currant, plum, and blackberry with subtle notes of dried berb, coffee, and loamy earth. Layered in complexity with flavors of dark cherry and cocoa, this wine bas rich, refined tannins that lead to a long, elegant finish."
