

2023 Grape Production Report

2023 Washington wine grape production totaled 159,000 tons, a 34% decrease from 2022

- Cabernet Sauvignon was the top producing variety grown in the state at 48,369 tons or 30% of the total. Riesling overtook Chardonnay for second place, at 24,357 tons or 15% of the total.
- The top seven varieties represented 88% of the overall tonnage, including (in order of tonnage) Cabernet Sauvignon, Riesling, Chardonnay, Syrah, Merlot, Sauvignon Blanc, and Pinot Gris.
- Red varieties accounted for 59% of total production, versus 57% in 2022. Overall red varieties
 experienced a decrease of 32% while white varieties experienced a 36% decrease.
- Growers received an average of \$1,542 per ton for all varieties in 2023, an increase of \$172 over the
 previous year. For the second year in a row, Cabernet Franc received the highest average price per
 ton.
